1945

- Enlisted in Army Air Force and assigned to Pre-Aviation Cadet Training, Keesler AFB, Biloxi, Mississippi, June 15
- Transferred to Tuskegee Army Airfield, Pilot Class 46D for pre-flight and Lower Primary, June 27
- War ended and subsequently training was discontinued

1951

- Recalled to active duty (Korean Conflict) and served with Air Police units at Mitchell and Langley Air Force Bases

1952

- Separated from military service, August

1953

- Recalled in March and assigned to Navigator Program, Ellington AFB
- Appointed class captain
- Resigned from military service

1953

- Joined New York State Police then New York City Police and served as detective for 27 years.
